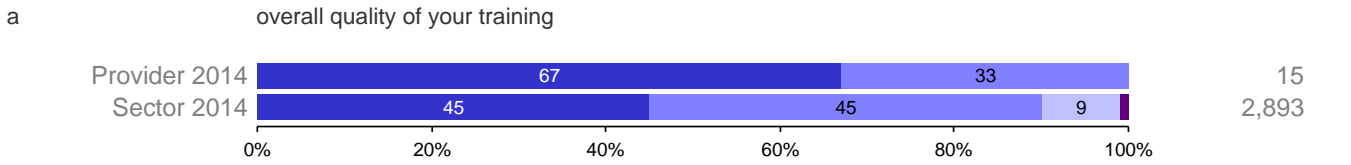


Figure 104 The newly qualified teacher survey

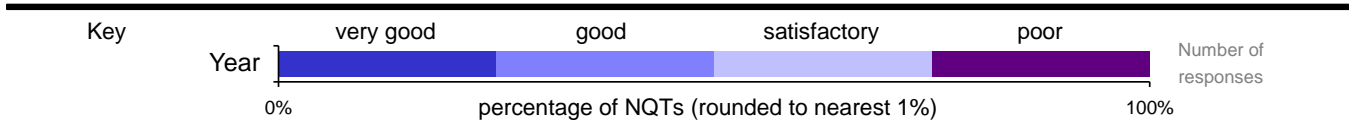
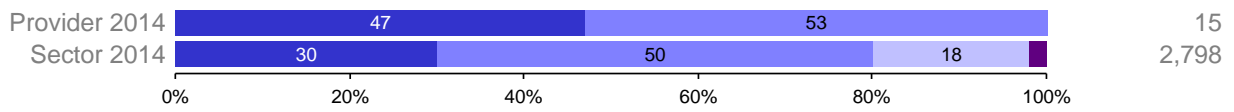


Figure 105 **The newly qualified teacher survey**

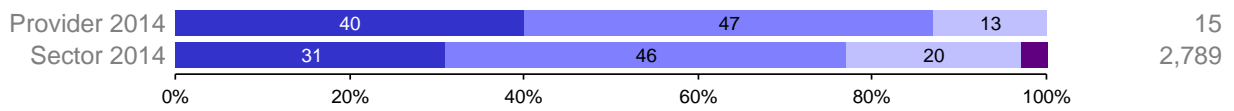
a **new in 2014** preparing you to be aware of pupils' capabilities and prior knowledge?

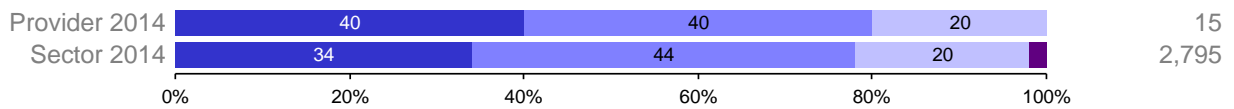

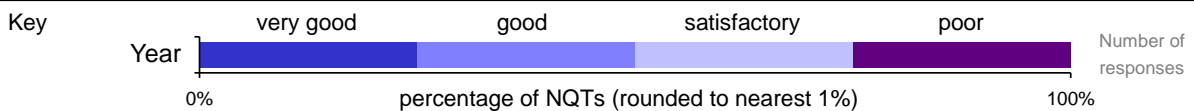


Figure 106 The newly qualified teacher survey

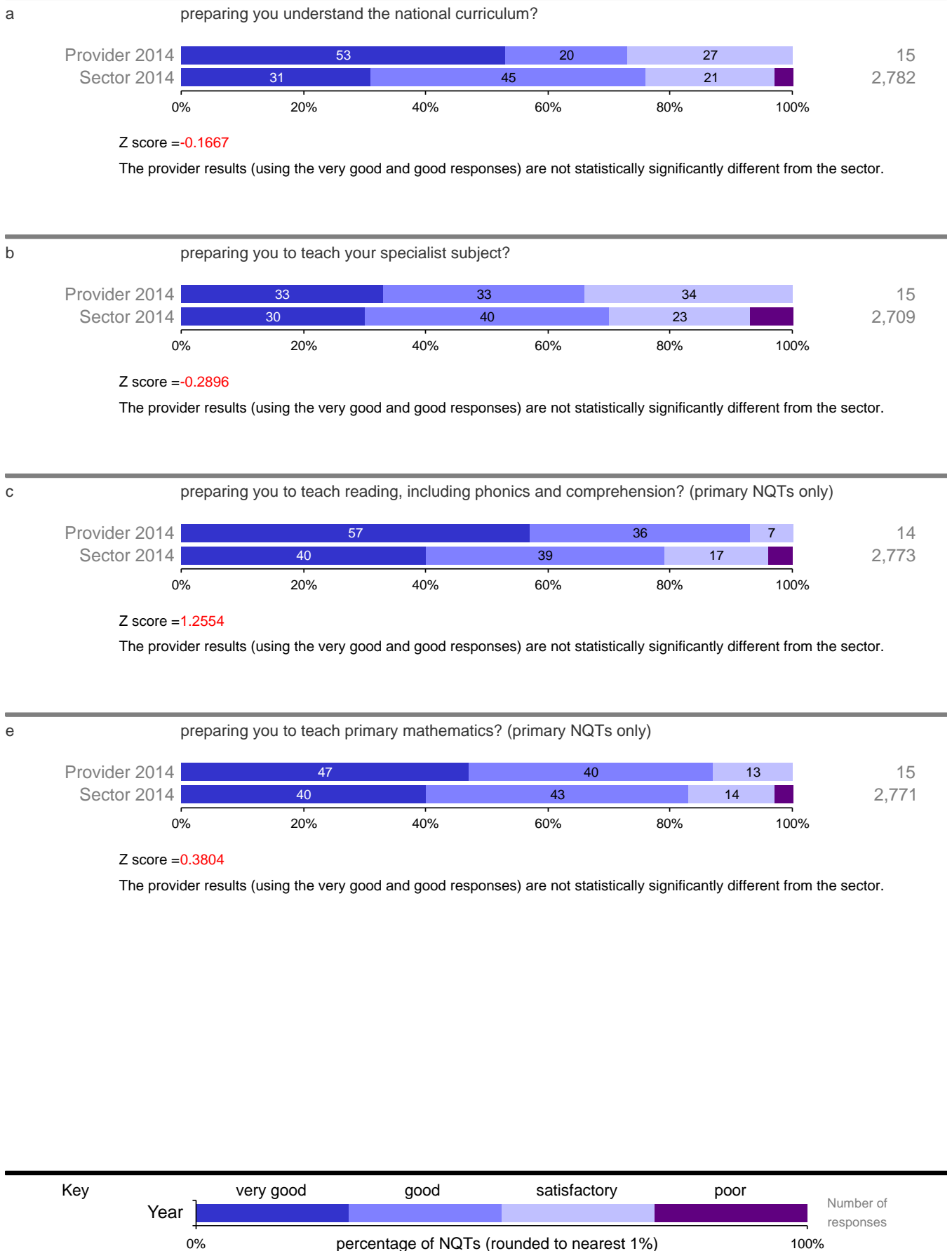
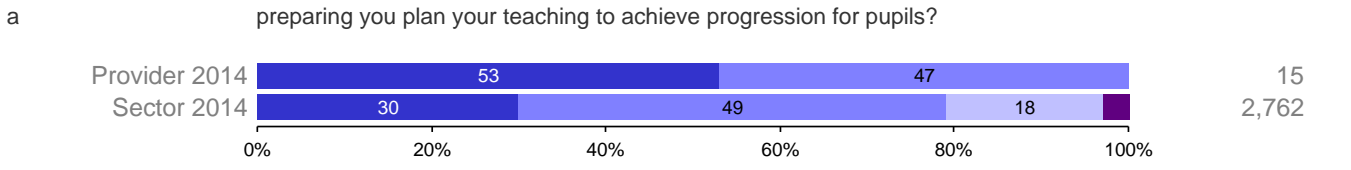


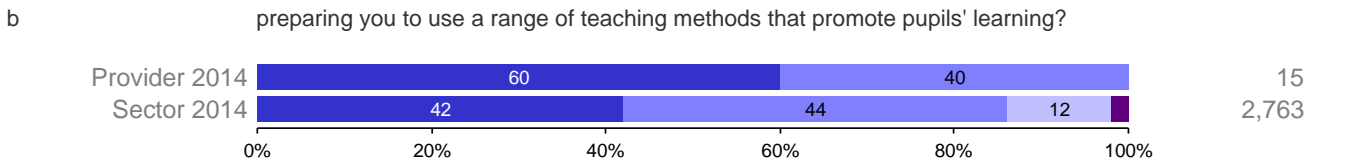
Figure 107 The newly qualified teacher survey

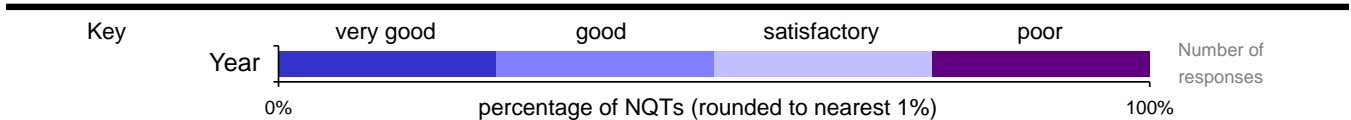
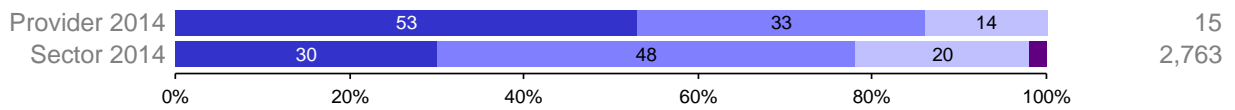


Figure 108 **The newly qualified teacher survey**

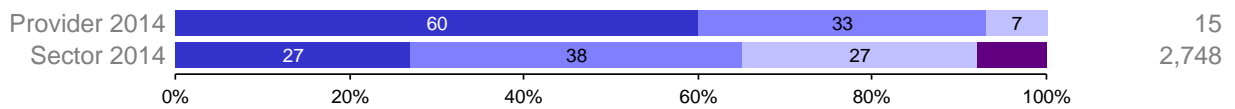
a preparing you to teach across the range of abilities?

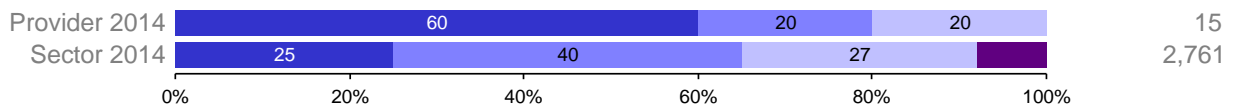
b preparing you to teach pupils from all ethnic backgrounds?

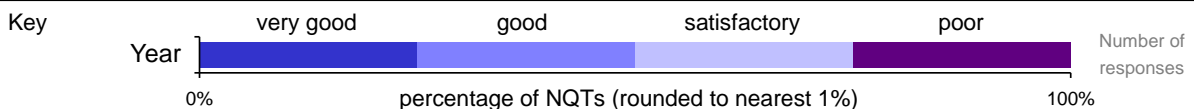


Figure 109 The newly qualified teacher survey

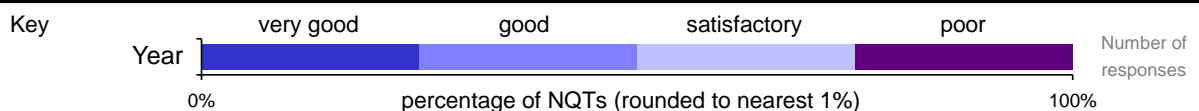

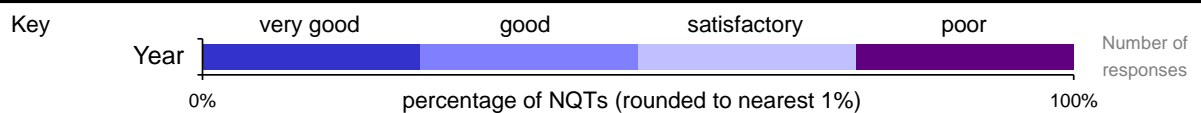
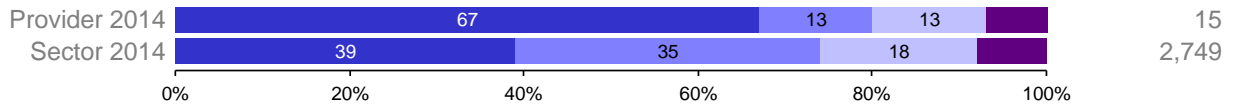
