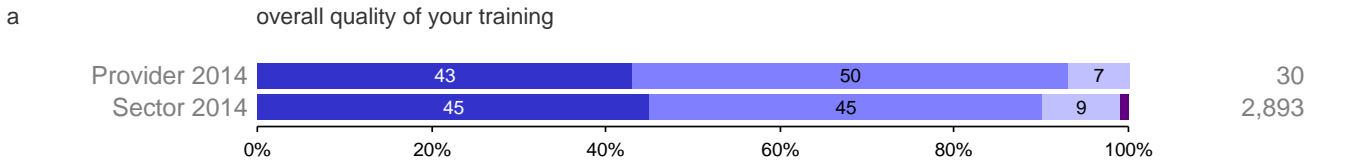


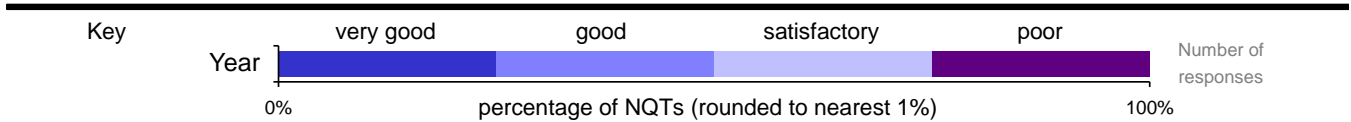
**Figure 104**      **The newly qualified teacher survey**

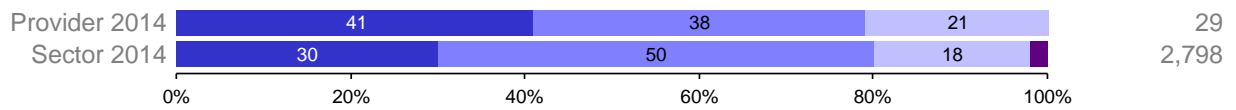
**Figure 105**

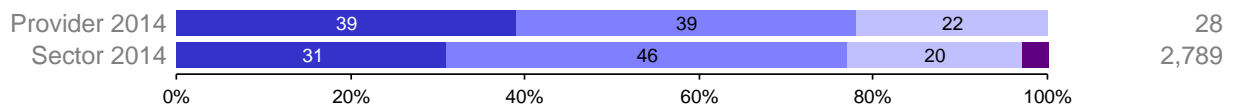
a **new in 2014** preparing you to be aware of pupils' capabilities and prior knowledge?

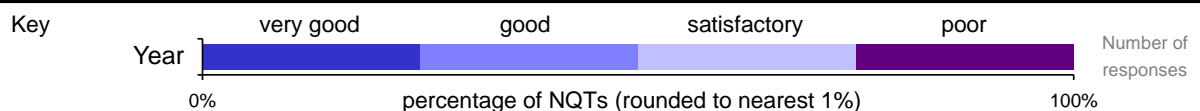

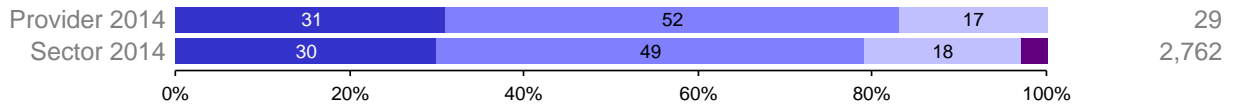


**Figure 107**      **The newly qualified teacher survey**

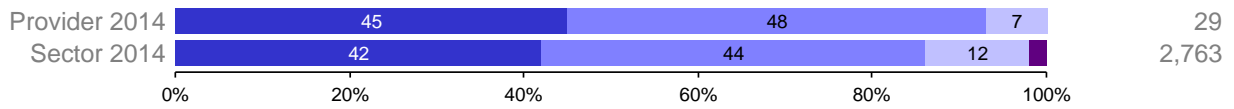

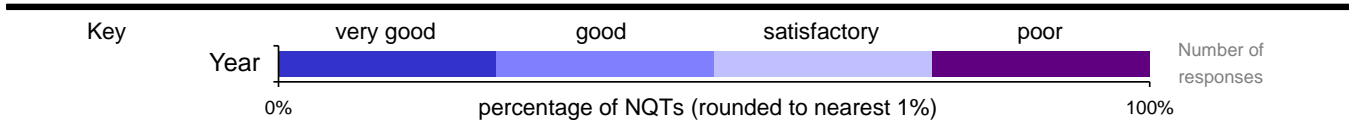

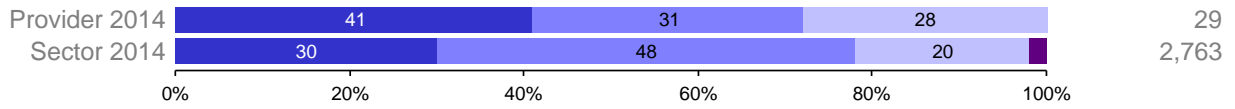

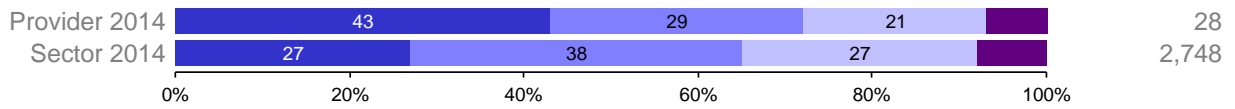

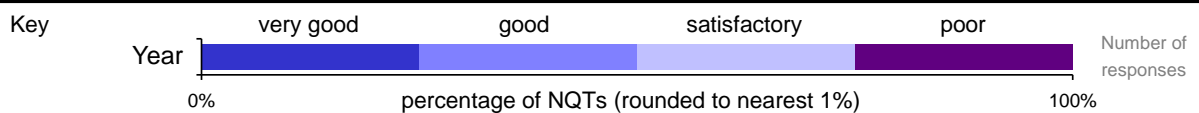
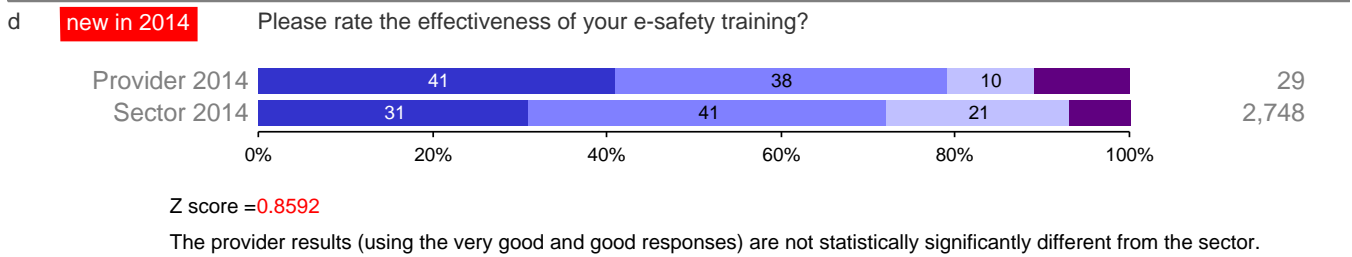
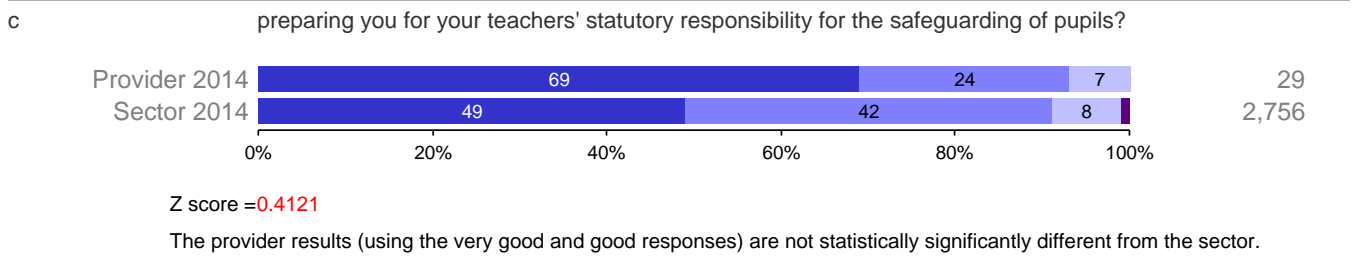
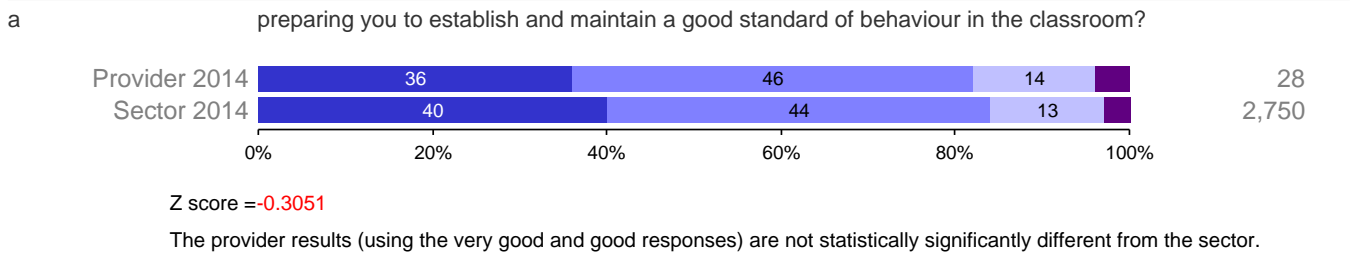
**Figure 109**      **The newly qualified teacher survey**

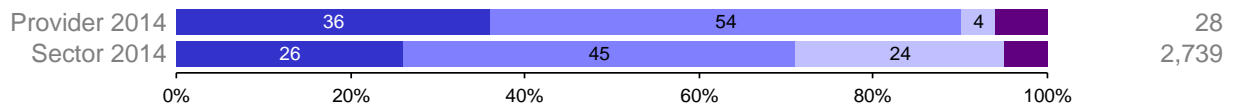

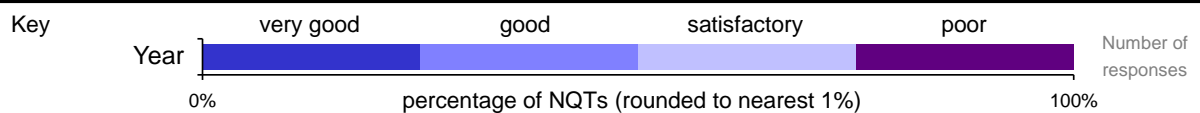

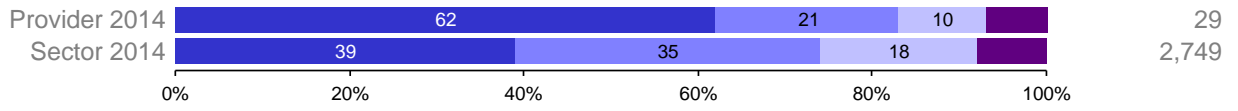
