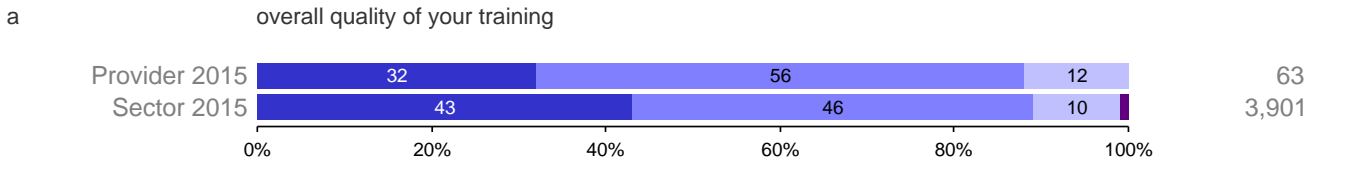


Figure 104 The newly qualified teacher survey

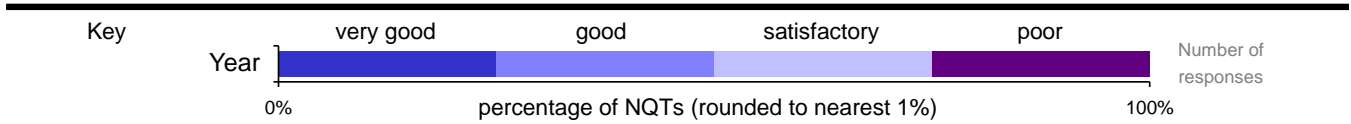
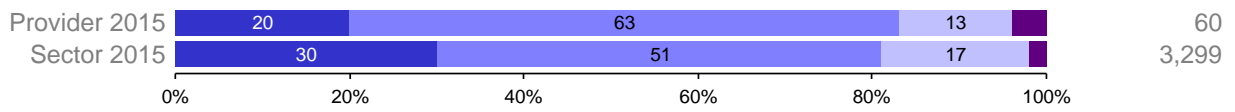


Figure 105 **The newly qualified teacher survey**

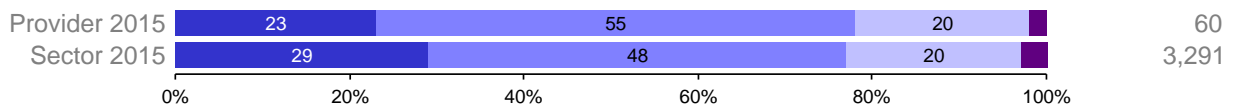
a **new in 2014** preparing you to be aware of pupils' capabilities and prior knowledge?

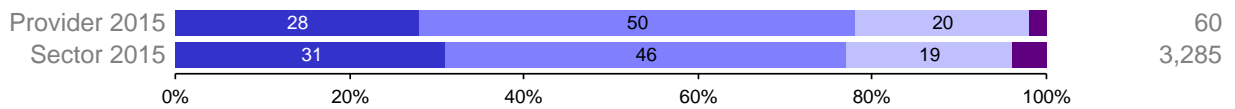

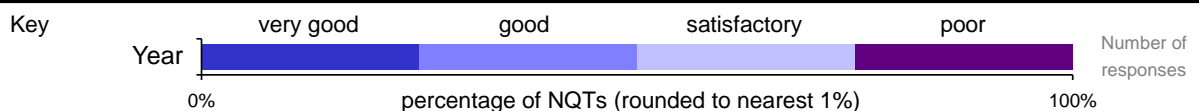


Figure 106 The newly qualified teacher survey

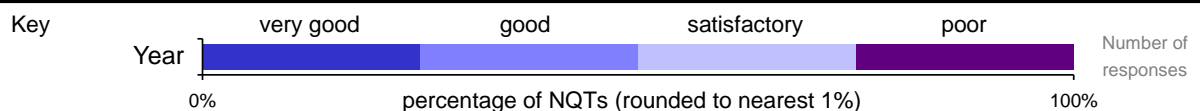
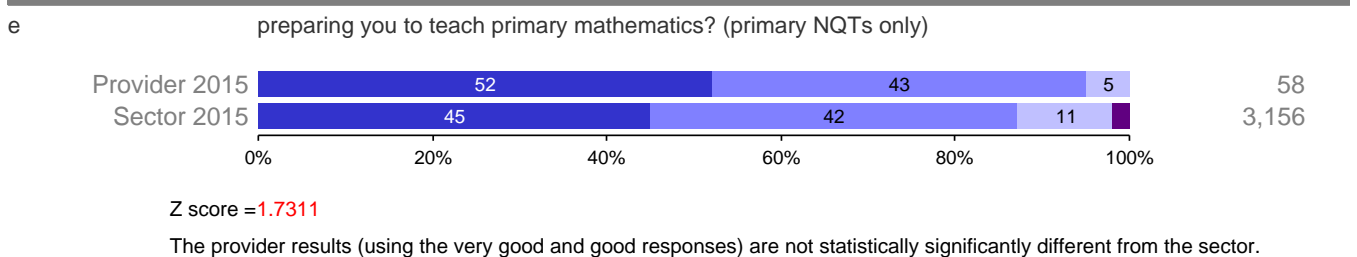
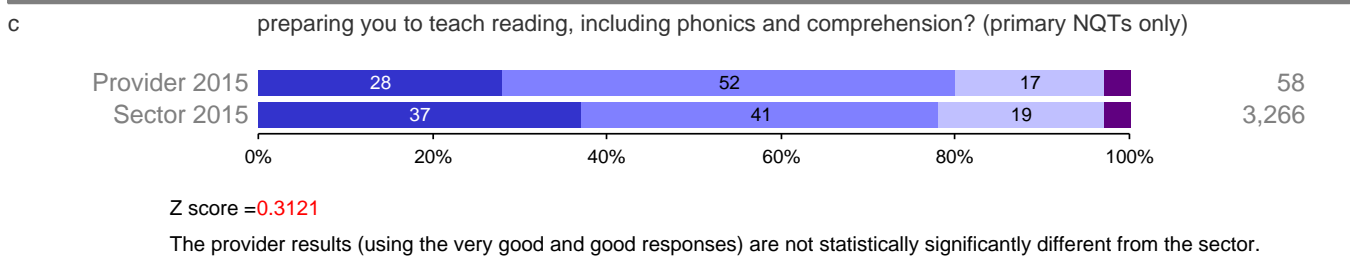
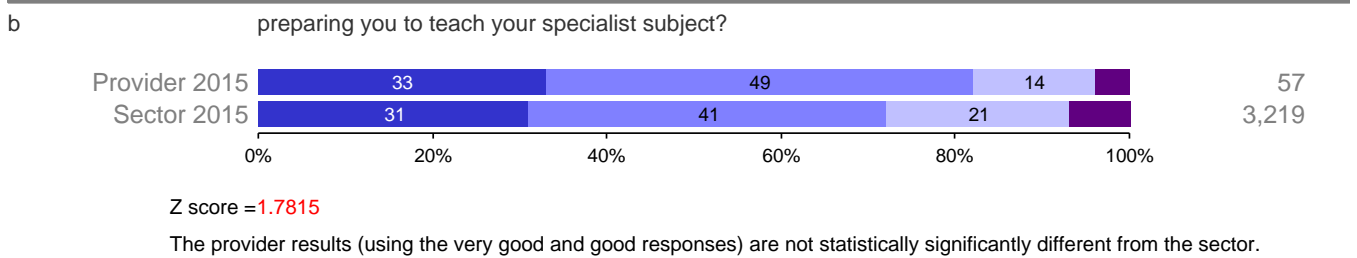
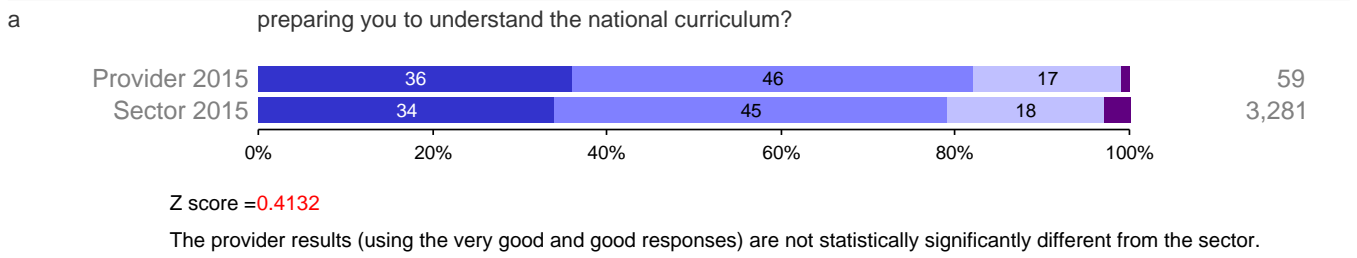
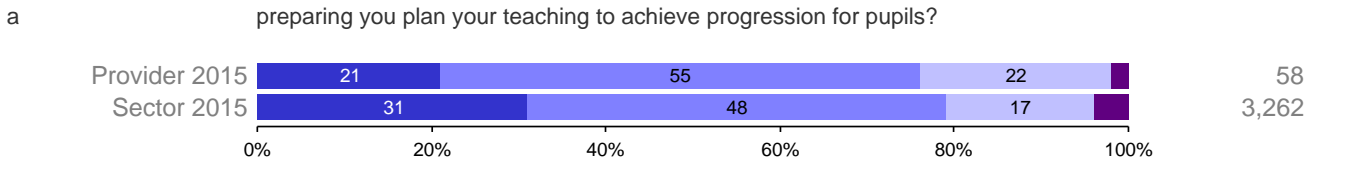


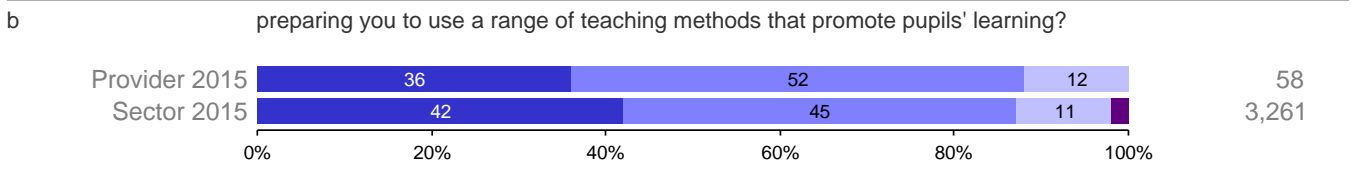
Figure 107 **The newly qualified teacher survey**

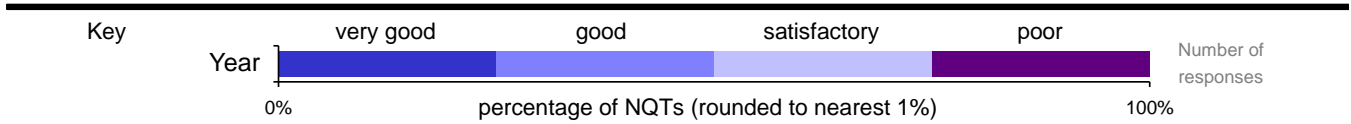


Figure 108 **The newly qualified teacher survey**

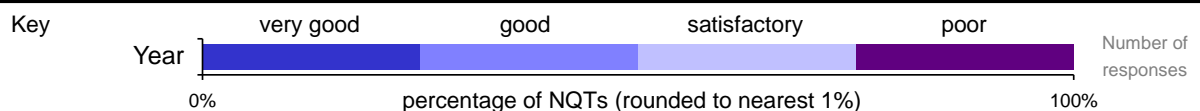
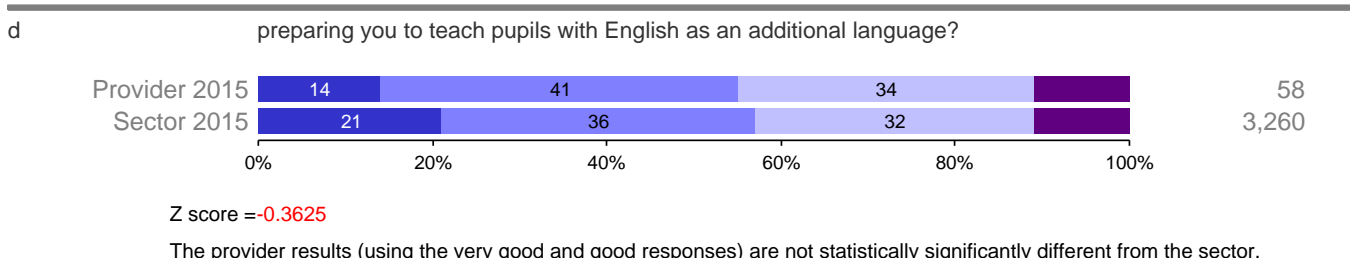
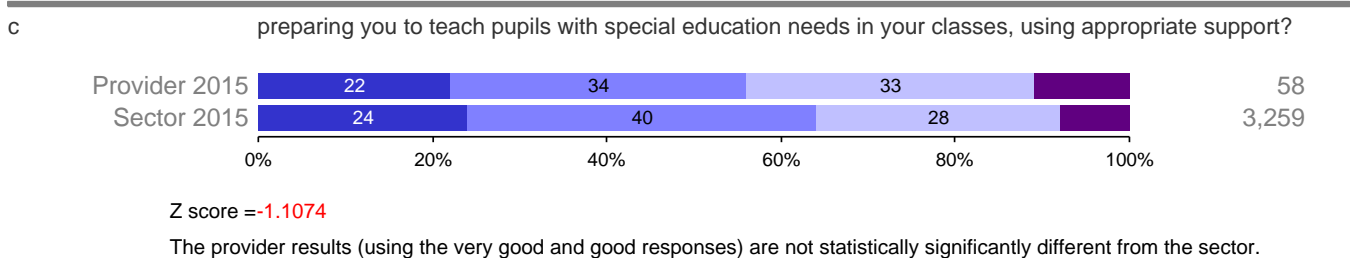
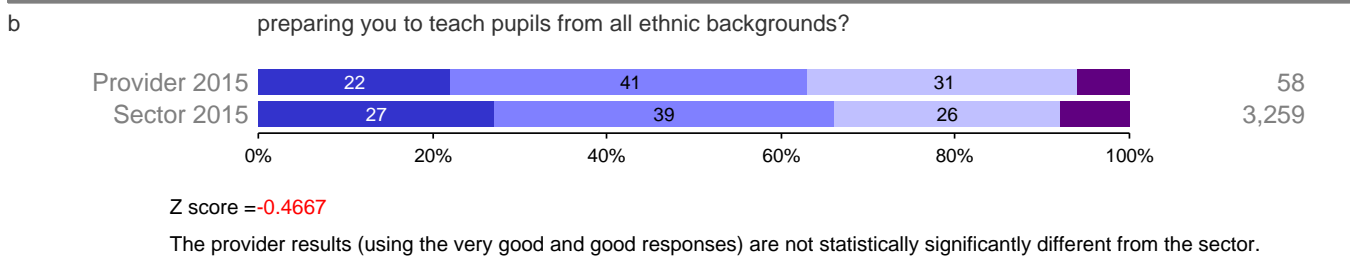
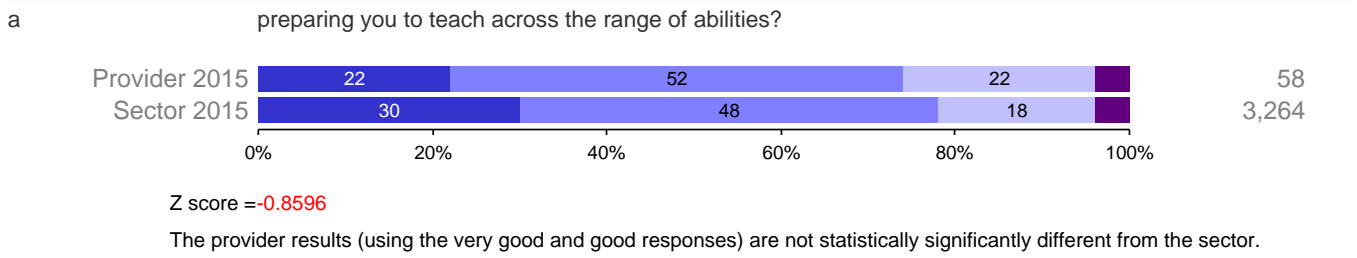
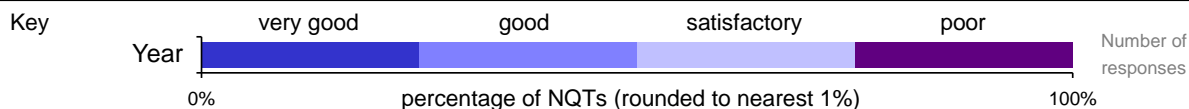
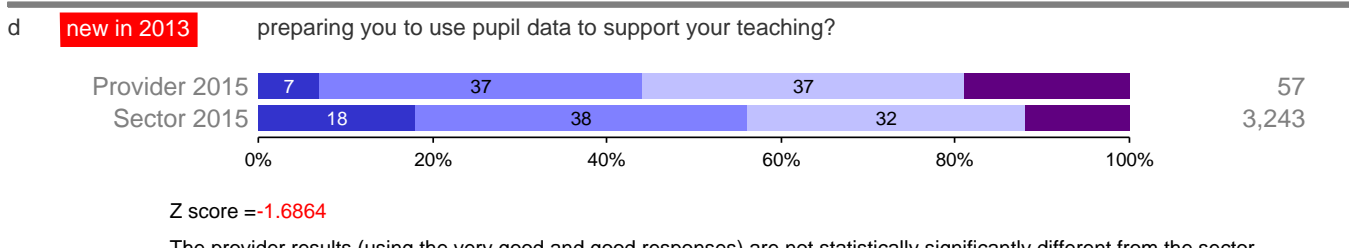
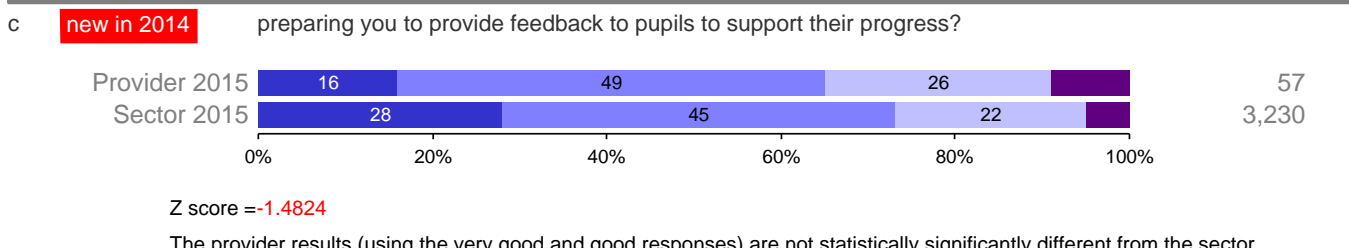
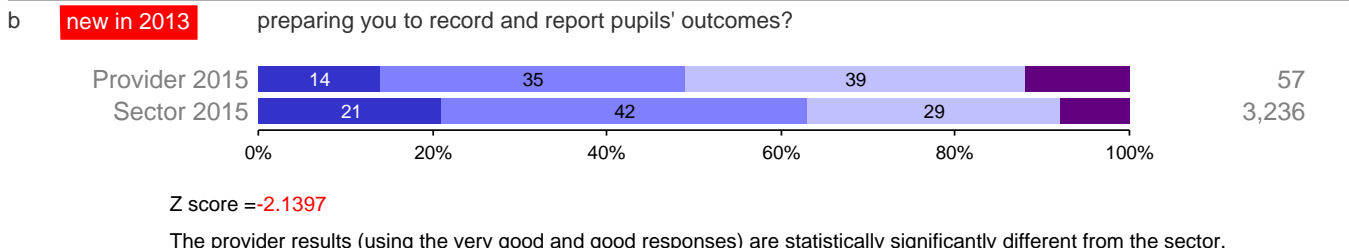
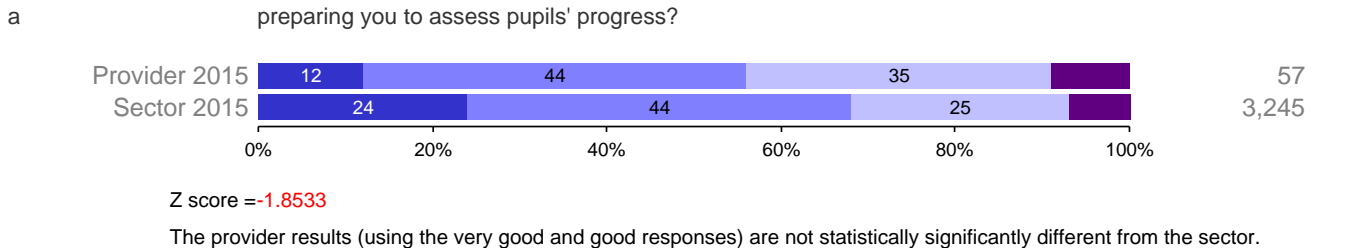


Figure 109 **The newly qualified teacher survey**

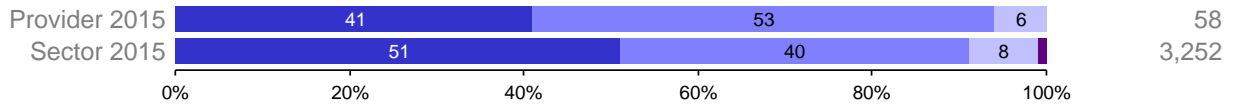

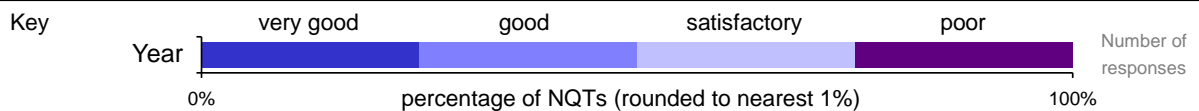
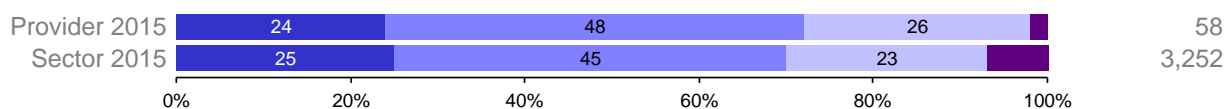

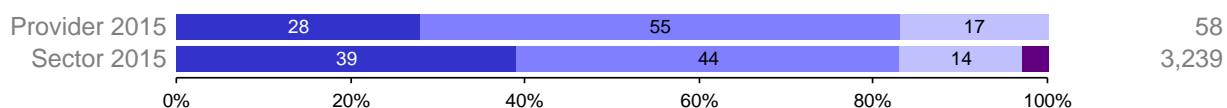

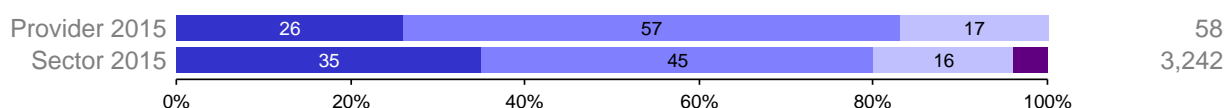

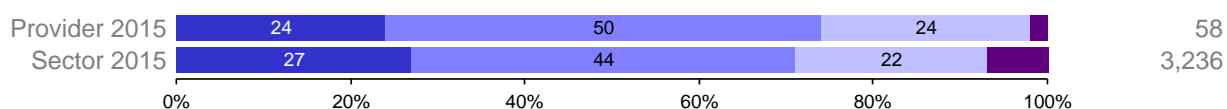

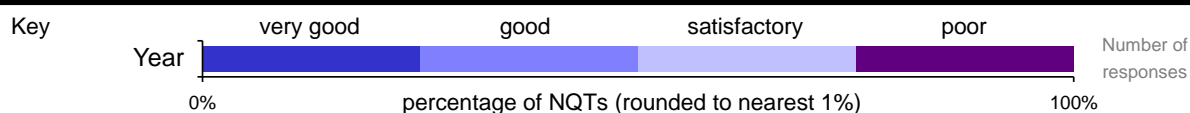

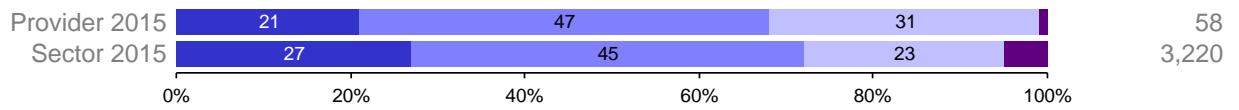

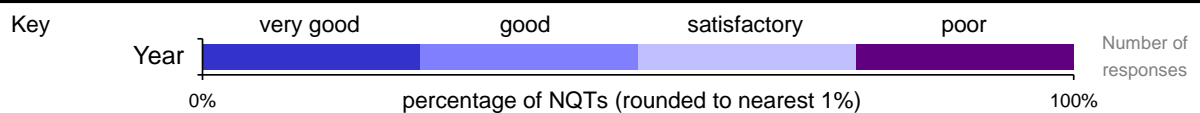
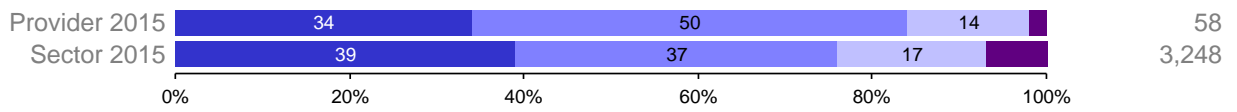
