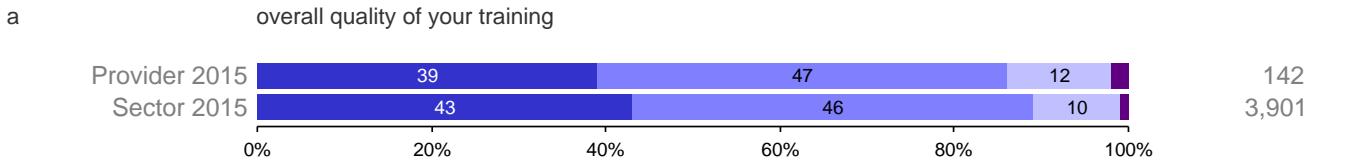


Figure 104 **The newly qualified teacher survey**

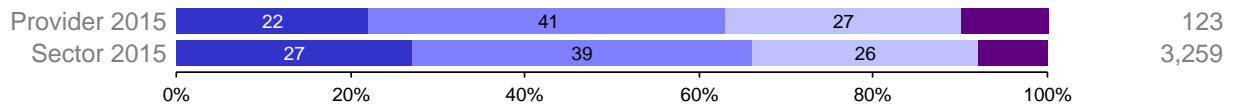
a preparing you to teach across the range of abilities?

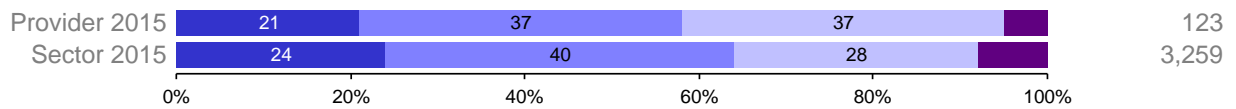

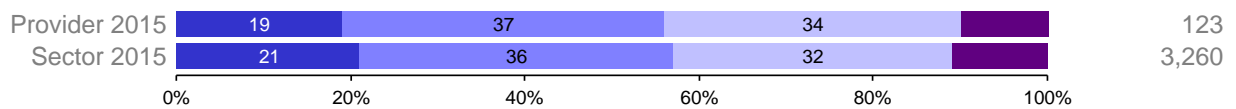

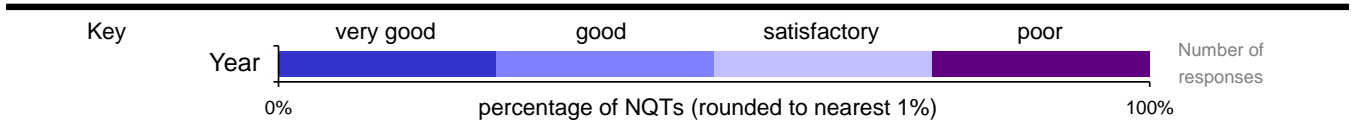

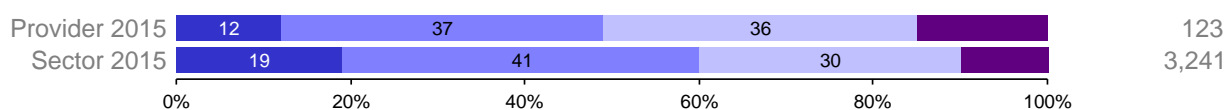

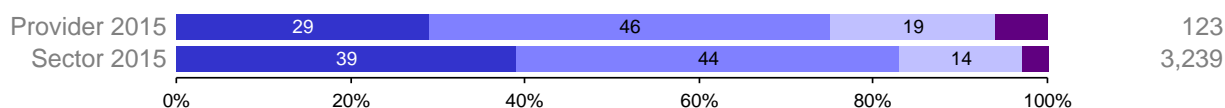

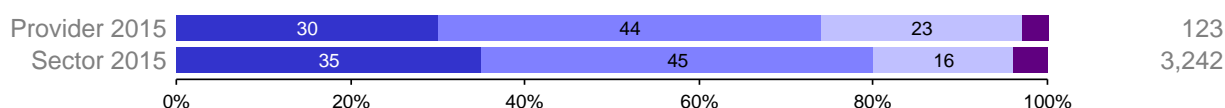

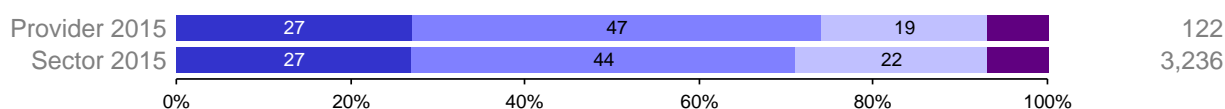

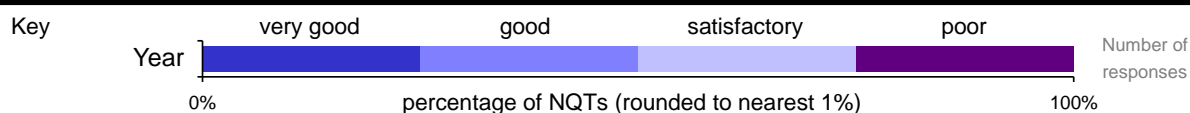

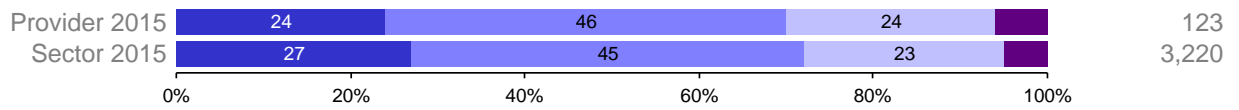
